# **Bulletin 1**

The CBEAW - Brazilian Water Ski & Wakeboard Confederation and the Pan American Confederation are pleased to invite all the Pan American Federations and their members to the **2022 IWWF Pan American Wakeboard Championships** which will take place from 11 to 15 of May 2022 at the Clube Serra da Moeda in Belo Horizonte, Minas Gerais - Brazil, and will be carried out under the supervision and rules of the IWWF.

### **1. LOCATION / PLACE OF COMPETITION**

Clube Serra da Moeda – Nova Lima (Belo Horizonte) – Minas Gerais - Brazil.

Located at the lake “Lagoa dos Ingleses” in Nova Lima 35 km away from Belo Horizonte and 75 km away from Confins International Airport (CNF)

**AIRPORT** - Athletes should make travel arrangements to arrive at the Confins International Airport (CNF) in Confins, Minas Gerais.

Teams must organize the transport from the airport to the hotel/competition site.

**RENT-A-CAR** - Alternatively, participants may choose to use any of the major rent-a-car companies that are available at Confins International Airport.

**TRANSFER HOTEL-EVENT SITE-HOTEL** – Provided by the organization to the teams and officials

## 2. WEATHER

In Nova Lima, the month of May is characterized by an average low temperature of 12°C and an average high temperature of 28°C.

The climate is moderate cold and all riders will enjoy the very little probability of rain.

## 3. CURRENCY

The Brazilian local currency is REAL (BRL).

On Dec 09, 2021 the exchange rate for USD 1,00 is BRL 5,57

Visa, American Express and MasterCard are accepted almost everywhere

## 4. VISAS

The participants in the 2022 Pan American Championships coming from countries that require VISA to visit Brazil, will be able to have an invitation letter issued by the Brazilian Confederation attesting that they will be attending the event. It is important to mention that the VISA must be obtained in the Embassy or Brazilian Consulate BEFORE the departure from the country of residence, so we suggest you to carry out the process with anticipation.

Registration for the event will cost USD 250,00 per participant and will have to be paid at the site BEFORE the event starts on May 10, 2022 (Cash only).

The final RIDER'S LIST who will participate must be sent **NO LATER** than **April 30, 2022**. After this date, for the late submission of the registration a penalty fee of USD 10,00 per day per rider will be applied.

## 8. TRAINING

**UNOFFICIAL PRACTICE** - There will be an unofficial familiarization on May 10 (Tuesday) at a cost of USD 30,00 per rider (~10 minutes) and must be paid in cash before the start of the training. Time slots for this training must be scheduled by e-mail with Daniel Garcia ([garciawake.com@gmail.com](mailto:garciawake.com@gmail.com))

**OFFICIAL TRAINING** – May 11 and 12 (Wednesday and Thursday) – According to the 2019 rule book, chapter 3.7

Time slots for official training must be requested by email to Daniel Garcia ([garciawake.com@gmail.com](mailto:garciawake.com@gmail.com)). Time slots will be given on a first asked, first served basis. The cost will be USD 300,00 per hour (USD 50,00 for 10 minutes). Only one time slot will be available per rider, at a time that is suitable to the team. Time slots are of 10 minutes, which mean 2 full passes on the course or 3 falls, whichever occurs first. Training should be paid in cash before the start, directly to the organization.

### 13. ENTRY REQUIREMENTS AND TEAM NOMINATIONS

It is the sole responsibility of IWWF-affiliated National Federations to select and enter their riders. No individual entries will be accepted. Federation entries only.

Each Federation may select its team in any manner it desires. However, each team member must be a citizen or applying for citizenship of the country that the Federation represents. In case of doubt as to the nationality of a competitor, the Chief Judge and Chief Calculator normally will refer to his/her passport.

If a rider does not have a passport from the country he/she is representing, he/she must prove residence in the country for at least five years and membership in an affiliated club of the Federation. Each Federation shall certify that all members of its team meet these qualifications.

Prior to competing, a competitor must sign a participation contract and understand the nature of the sport and its special risks, particularly in the format. It is the responsibility of the competitor to register with the designated registration person and show proof of Federation membership before riding. Competitors must disclose to the event organizer any

special medical conditions, including but not limited to, injuries in the past or present or other pre-existing medical conditions.

TEAM SCORING:

Please read points 2.7.6, 3.8 and 3.9 on the 2019 World Rulebook.

## 14. LIABILITY

The organizer Committee and PanAm Federation will not be liable for any loss or damage to equipment or personal property, and injuries to athletes, officials, judges, official volunteers, and other persons attending official or unofficial programmers during the event.

Athletes are required to purchase and show proof of personal accident insurance prior to entry.

The insurance policy must provide coverage internationally. The organizer will not be responsible for any injury sustained, at any time, by any athlete from his participation in these events.

The costs incurred for medical treatment and hospitalization in private hospitals in Brazil are high. Adequate personal medical insurance coverage is necessary.

Certificate of medical insurance coverage/full payment is required before medical treatment/hospitalization takes place.

All riders have to sign a liability form, and riders under 18 need their parents to sign as well. Each Team Captain has to give Liability forms of all his athletes at the Registration.

## 15. DOPING CONTROL

In accordance with the IWWF Anti-Doping Rules, doping controls may be conducted during the competition. By entering this competition, all athletes agree to be subject to doping control. Information about the IWWF Anti-Doping program, the current IWWF AD Rules and links to the list of banned substances can be accessed on the following link :

All riders must have their passports with them at any time during the competition. Please note, if you are randomly chosen for drug testing, and fail to identify yourself with your passport, or fail to take the test for any other reason, it will result with an immediate disqualification.

## 16. CATEGORIES

### **U14 - 14 and Under (Boys)**

14 years old and under - if you are 14 years or under on December 31st in the current year the event is held

### **U14 - 14 and Under (Girls)**

14 years old and under - if you are 14 years or under on December 31st in the current year the event is held

### **U18 - 18 years and Under (Junior Men)**

18 years and under – if you are 18 years or under on December 31st in the current year the event is held

### **U18 - 18 years and Under (Junior Women)**

18 years and under – if you are 18 years or under on December 31st in the current year the event is held

### **O30 - 30 Years and Over (Master Men)**

30 years or older on December 31st in the current year the event is held

### **O30 - 30 Years and Over (Master Women)**

30 years or older on December 31st in the current year the event is held

### **O40 - 40 Years and Over (Veteran Men)**

40 years or older on December 31st in the current year the event is held

### **O40 - 40 Years and Over (Veteran Women)**

40 years or older on December 31st in the current year the event is held

### **Open Division (Open Men)**

No age restriction

### **Open Division (Open Women)**

No age restriction

## 18. 2023 Pan American Games Qualifier

This event will be a qualifying event for the 2023 Pan American Games in Chile. Six (6) available spots for men and six (6) available spots for women will be assigned. The host country (Chile) has one (1) spot available for each gender - already assigned. The remaining spots (1 man/1 woman) will be assigned during the South American Games in Asuncion, Paraguay.

**IMPORTANT:** Please keep in mind that these spots are for the countries and not for the individual athletes. If an athlete attains a spot at this event, he/she has obtained the spot for the country and the athlete that will attend the Games in 2023 is up to the discretion of the athlete's country.

## 19. Covid Protocols

All Covid Protocols will be respected and enforced where possible according to the requirements of the local Brazilian government.
